We are good in time/good in the time	We are <u>right on</u> time We are <u>right on</u> schedule

We are going today with the train to Bremen.	We are going to Bremen by train today. Today we are going to Bremen by train. We are taking the train to Bremen today. Today we are taking the train to Bremen.
There was a large amount of cars on the street.	There was a large <u>number</u> of cars on the street. (countable nouns)
We go to the movies tomorrow. Are you coming with?	We're <u>going to go</u> the movies tomorrow. Are you coming <u>along</u> ? (Or: Do you want to come along?)
The accident happened in the night.	The accident happened <u>at</u> night.
There will be five more speeches after the food.	There will be five more speeches after <u>lunch</u> .
I hope you have all made a great experience at the conference of today.	I hope that you have all <u>had</u> a great experience at <u>today's</u> conference.
